

Insurance for offenders, their families, partners, employers and landlords

You will need insurance if you want to own your own car, rent or buy your home or start a new business. It will be necessary to disclose your **unspent** conviction/s even **if not asked**, as this in itself is an offence. More importantly your home including rented accommodation (so your landlord must know), or car will not be covered and therefore claims will not be paid. Don't be tempted to put the insurance in someone else's name, that you are using the car or living in the home will make the insurance invalid. **Take care check what is and is not provided by a policy and whether you might obtain better value from another insurance company**
