step 1) go to <http://www.niace.org.uk/alw/2008/forum/>

step 2) click "Register"

step 3) read the Terms and conditions and click "I agree to these terms"

step 4) fill out the form with: your user name (the name that you will be know by in the forum), a valid email address, a password (which must be longer than 6 characters), your full name, job title, organisation and telephone number.

step 5) type in the confirmation code that you see in the picture (this is case sensitive. NB: no zeros are used so if you see an "O" it will be an "O" not a zero)

step 6) click submit

step 7) please take a moment to read through the welcome message, forum rules and glossary to familiarise yourself with the forum.

If you have any **technical questions**, first try looking in the **FAQs** section for an answer (top right hand corner).

If you are still stuck, post a message in the **"Any Questions"** forum once you have logged on (which is in the **"Ideas Forum"**) and one of the moderators will get back to you.
