exceptionally high standard of work that they have produced. There are three categories to the exhibition, 3 to 11 years, 11 to 15 years and 16 to 19 years. "The "Children and Young peoples Art Exhibition" has been



organised by a group of enthusiastic and dedicated young people who have been working along side the councils Arts development team. They have basically organised, selected and promoted the whole thing." Said Andy.



The students didn't know their artwork was going to be put in the exhibition until they had received a letter from their tutor telling them. Andy said "I did it this way because often students feel very self conscious

about displaying their work!"



All of the young people who had their work entered attended the private viewing of the exhibition and received a certificate for exhibiting their work. The show is running until September 12 and is free entry.
